Walkinshaw Andretti United was born from three iconic organisations in world motor sport, Walkinshaw Racing, Andretti Autosport, and United Autosports.

The three organisations cover the globe, with Walkinshaw Racing based in Australia, Andretti Autosport in America, and United Autosports in Europe.

The announcement of Walkinshaw Andretti United took place at the most iconic circuit in Australia, Bathurst, on the eve of the biggest race of the 2017 season, the Bathurst 1000. It sent chins wagging, as fans around the globe pondered what these three teams can achieve together.

It didn't take long for the first win to be achieved through Scott Pye's famous victory at the 2018 Australian Grand Prix event, with five further podiums coming in the first season. The Team has also stood on the Bathurst podium every year since its formation.

2021 saw the Team have its most successful season to date, claiming three wins, including Chaz Mostert and Lee Holdsworth's stunning victory in the 2021 Bathurst 1000. Mostert also finished third in the Drivers' Championship, with the Team finishing fourth in the Teams.


Access to entering motor sports as a career is often limited by a person's connections, wealth and education. This means we are limited in attracting the best and the brightest the world has to offer.


The Walkinshaw Andretti United Foundation Academy (WAU Foundation Academy) aims to build a long-term, credible and sustainable pathway program to motor sports excellence.

This program will use the positive effect of our new premises alongside specific training tools, particularly in simulation learning and physical preparation, to create a program of High Performance - specific to our professional motor sport.

The structure of the WAU Foundation Academy is focused to provide a pipeline of opportunity for elite talent into the 'main game' of Supercars.

AT ITS CORE. THE PREMISE IS TO ALLOW THE BEST TALENT TO RISE - IRRESPECTIVE OF FUNDING, BACKGROUND, OR WEALTH. WE WANT TO OPEN DOORS AND INTENSIFY TALENT.

The developmental approach is spread across three tiers of Australian motor sport:



The development is coordinated in alliance with major educational partners across Australia, including UNSW and Kangan Institute.

Each stage of the development encompasses integration across the WAU businesses entrance into these categories.

As such the WAU Foundation Academy can have a focus on developing burgeoning talent across these categories via workshop training, direct at track experience as well as planned and frequent integration with the race team operations at Clayton, Victoria.


Noting regionally, we also have the opportunity to commence a New Zealand partnership in T86, as well as potentially cultivating a New Zealand aspiring driver into Super2.





CREATING A PIPELINE FOR TALENT

It is anticipated that at least twenty 12-month positions will be available annually to students through the WAU Foundation Academy including:



Students will have access to a tailored program stream.

Each program within the WAU Foundation Academy - supported by our partners Kangan Institute and UNSW - is necessarily bespoke, with the educational partner and program manager assisting the tailoring to each driver, student and/or mechanical intern.


Students will have a minimum 50 contact days over the year, integrated across all core competencies.

For all, the program encompasses the following distinct high-performance training and touch points:

- Direct at track racing experience
- Integration into WAU workshop program including:
 - -Toolbox training
 - **Direct supervised instruction**
 - WAU summer training (school) _
- Access into WAU simulator sessions, training, and integration
- Assimilation into WAU physical personal training sessions and gym resource
- Integration into pre-brief and debrief sessions
- Other opportunities within the WAU network locally and internationally
- Secondment to other teams
- Commercial motor sport education, attitudinal approach, and opportunity development

THE PATHWAY

We all came to racing through different paths, some straight, some windy. Some knew this is where they would end, others found racing mid-way.

At the Walkinshaw Andretti United Foundation Academy we acknowledge this and have created several pathways to racing.

HIGH SCHOOL CADET

WAU Foundation Academy will use the F1 in School STEM Challenge to identify talented business and engineering students for entry into the program.

APPRENTICESHIPS

With one of the strongest apprenticeship programs in Victoria, Kangan Institute has a diverse range of automotive courses to prepare students for real world racing who would be considered for entry to the WAU Academy.

UNIVERSITY UNDERGRAD STUDENTS

In partnership with UNSW, we will consider entry for WAU's High School Cadets into their Sunswift Racing Program, as well as including Sunswift students into the WAU Foundation Academy.

GRADUATE STUDENTS

In the years to come, graduates of UNSW, and those that apply directly to the Academy, will have entry to a Graduate program.

JUNIOR DRIVER PROGRAM

Awareness of young talent comes through an organic process that has existed for decades in scouting and keeping an eye on all motor sports categories.






